Answer: Truman CAPOTE or Truman Streckfus PERSONS

2. Their win over Pittsburgh in Game 16 at Lambeau Field gave them their first division title in twenty-three years. FTP, name this NFC Central team who boasts the league's MVP, quarterback Brett Favre.

Answer: GREEN BAY or PACKERS

3. Its Great Dark Spot is a cyclonic disturbance about the size of Earth and the methane in its atmosphere produces this planet's characteristic color. FTP, name this planet, currently the farthest from the sun.

Answer: NEPTUNE (NOT Jupiter, which has a "Great Red Spot")

4. Doctors hope that Jeff Getty's recent operation boosts his immune system which has been weakened by AIDS. Getty received an infusion of bone marrow from, FTP, what type of primate?

Answer: BABOON

5. The Paris Salon originally rejected his *Man with a Broken Nose*, but later accepted it under the title *Portrait of a Roman*. FTP, name this sculptor known for *The Age of Bronze*, *The Kiss* and *The Thinker*.

Answer: François Auguste Rene RODIN

6. Age, dancing, storm, chest, sheet, pick, cube, and cream can all be preceded by, FTP, what 3-letter word to form logical phrases?

Answer: ICE

7. Although still a Democrat at the time, he replaced David Kennedy as Nixon's Secretary of the Treasury, but he may be best remembered for riding with John Kennedy in a limousine. FTP, name this former Texas governor.

Answer: John Bowden CONNALLY Jr.

8. After Kate Moss refused to make a three-year commitment, Amber Valletta, Shalom (sha-LOME) Harlow and Linda Evangelista are now among the models being considered to replace Cindy Crawford as the hostess of, FTP, what MTV fashion program?

Answer: HOUSE OF STYLE

9. Located on the Salt River, it is the nation's most populous state capital and also serves as the seat of Maricopa County. FTP, name this southwestern US city.

Answer: PHOENIX, Arizona

10. Its title is taken from "Harlem", a poem by Langston Hughes, and it tells the story of the Youngers, a black family living on the south side of Chicago. FTP, name this three-act play by Lorraine Hansberry.

Answer: A RAISIN IN THE SUN

11. Among this MIT professor's political works are *Manufacturing Consent* and *American Power and the New Mandarins*. FTP, name this man, whose 1957 book *Syntactic Structures* introduced his theory of transformational generative grammar.

Answer: (Avram) Noam CHOMSKY

12. Dr. Claude Gubler was recently sued by this man's family for violating medical privacy by disclosing that this man had hidden his cancer from the public for a decade. FTP, name this former French president.

Answer: François MITTERAND

13. They have well-developed nervous systems with complex brains and are the only mollusks with closed circulatory systems. FTP, name this group of animals that includes squids and octopods and whose name means "head foot".

Answer: CEPHALOPODA or CEPHALOPODS

14. In the same year that her father William X died, she married Louis VII, but after that marriage was annulled, she married Henry II, adding to his French holdings. FTP, name this queen who spent 15 years in semi-confinement.

Answer: ELEANOR of Aquitaine

15. It was designed by Karl Gotthard Langhans who used as his model the Propylaea, a Doric gateway to the Acropolis in Athens. FTP, name this monumental landmark in Berlin.

Answer: BRANDENBURG GATE

16. It was probably named from the Tibetan word for "willow root," which is usually what the ball used is made of. FTP, name this game, divided into 7 and one-half minute periods called chukkers and played with mallets and ponies.

Answer: POLO

Answer: Dr. Martin Luther KING Jr.

Answer: Billy JOEL

Answer: SHROUD OF TURIN or HOLY SHROUD

21. Many of his terms and symbols have become standard, including "F of X", "p", "e" and "i". FTP, name this 18th-century Swiss mathematician who also contributed to probability, optics and mechanics.

Answer: Leonhard or Leonard EULER (OY-ler)

22. So named by Virginia Congressman, John Randolph, they included Peter Porter, Felix Grundy, John C. Calhoun and Henry Clay. FTP, name this group of Republicans who pressed for war against Britain in 1810-11.

Answer: WAR HAWKS
