ARGENTINA

2. ALTHOUGH HE TWICE RECEIVED THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDAL OF FREEDOM AS WELL AS A PULITZER PRIZE, THIS MAN IS PROBABLY BEST KNOWN AS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT FIGURES OF THE TRUMAN ADMINISTRATION. THE RESULTS OF HIS EFFORTS INCLUDED THE MARSHALL PLAN, NATO, AND THE TRUMAN DOCTRINE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS MAN WHO WAS TRUMAN'S SECRETARY OF STATE FROM 1949 TO 1953.

DEAN ACHESON

3. STEPHEN SONDHEIM AND JAMES LAPINE TEAMED UP TO WIN A PULITZER PRIZE IN 1985 FOR THEIR MUSICAL INSPIRED BY THE LIFE AND WORKS OF THE PREMIER MASTER OF POINTILISM. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS MUSICAL THAT STARRED BERNADETTE PETERS AND MANDY PATINKIN AS GEORGE SEURAT.

JULES VERNE

6. UNLIKE MOST BIRDS, THIS BIRD HAS A LARGE, SOFT FLESHY TONGUE WHICH IT USES TO PUMP WATER THROUGH ITS BILL WHICH IT USES TO FILTER OUT FOOD. SINCE IT FEEDS WITH ITS HEAD UPSIDE DOWN, THE ROLES OF ITS UPPER AND LOWER BILLS ARE REVERSED , GIVING IT A CHARACTERISTIC SMILE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS BIRD OFTEN FOUND ON LAWNS IN A PINK, PLASTIC VARIETY.

7. FOR TEN POINTS, WHERE WOULD YOU HAVE FOUND THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE: JOSEPH McKENNA, WILLIS VAN DEVANTER, OWEN ROBERTS, JAMES IREDELL, JOHN MARSHALL HARLAN, EARL WARREN AND THURGOOD MARSHALL?

U.S. SUPREME COURT

8. THIS BOOK OPENS ON JULY 4, 1976 IN NEW YORK HARBOR, AND ENDS TEN YEARS LATER WITH THE DEATH OF BILL KRAUS. AMONG OTHERS, IT FOLLOWS THE LIVES OF POLITICAL AIDE CLEVE JONES, PLAYWRIGHT LARRY KRAMER, FLIGHT ATTENDANT GAETAN DUGAS (GAY-TEN DOO-GA), AND VIROLOGIST LUC MONTAGNIER. 10. IT EQUALS THE QUANTITY 1 PLUS THE SQUARE ROOT OF 5, DIVIDED BY 2; AND NUMERICALLY IT'S APPROXIMATELY 1.618. IT'S ALSO THE LIMIT OF THE RATIO OF SUCCESSIVE TERMS OF THE FIBONACCI SEQUENCE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS RATIO, OFTEN USED IN THE ART OF ANCIENT GREECE.

GOLDEN MEAN -- OR -- GOLDEN RATIO -- OR --
PHI -- OR -- DIVINE PROPORTION

11. IN ART, THE TERM PAPILLONTAGE REFERS TO THE COMMON PRACTICE AMONG ROCOCO PAINTERS TO PRESENT SCENES IN WHICH THE EYE IS DRAWN TO SEVERAL POINTS, CAUSING ONE'S EYES TO DART ALL ALONG THE ART WORK. THE TERM DERIVES ITS NAME FROM THE FRENCH WORD "PAPILLON" WHICH MEANS, FOR TEN POINTS, WHAT ENGLISH WORD, AN INSECT THAT TENDS TO FLY AROUND IN RANDOM PATTERNS.

BUTTERFLY

12. THIS POET'S FATHER OWNED THE CANDY COMPANY THAT INVENTED LIFESAVERS, BUT FAMILY PROBLEMS LED TO HIS MENTAL INSTABILITY THAT WOULD LEAD TO SUICIDE AT AGE 33. HIS MOST FAMOUS WORK WAS INSPIRED BY "THE WASTE LAND" AND "MOBY DICK", AND IT FEATURES APPEARANCES BY POCOHANTAS, COLUMBUS, RIP VAN WINKLE, WALT WHITMAN AND EDGAR ALLEN POE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS AMERICAN POET WHO WROTE "THE BRIDGE".

HART CRANE

13. THE GEORGIA HOUSE IN WHICH THIS AUTHOR SPENT MUCH TIME WRITING WAS RECENTLY GUTTED BY FIRE. A TELEVISION MOVIE IS SOON TO BE RELEASED ABOUT HER LIFE, IN WHICH SHE WILL BE PORTRAYED BY SHANNON DOHERTY. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS ONE-HIT LITERARY WONDER, THE AUTHOR OF "GONE WITH THE WIND".

MARGARET MITCHELL

14. HE WON 23 AND 24 GAMES IN CONSECUTIVE YEARS, AND HE LED THE LEAGUE WITH A 1.75 ERA AND NINE SHUTOUTS IN 1916. HE SET A WORLD SERIES RECORD WITH 29 2/3 CONSECUTIVE SCORELESS INNINGS, AND THE WORLD SERIES MVP AWARD IS NAMED AFTER HIM. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS BASEBALL PLAYER BETTER KNOWN FOR HIS HOME-RUN ACCOMPLISHMENTS LATER IN HIS CAREER.

GEORGE HERMANN "BABE" RUTH

15. THIS BRITISH MATHEMATICIAN DISCOVERED THE ANALOGY OF ALGEBRAIC SYMBOLS AND THOSE OF LOGIC. THIS ALLOWED FOR OPERATIONS THAT BROUGHT COMPUTER SWITCHING THEORY AND PROCEDURES. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS MAN FOR WHOM A BRANCH OF ALGEBRA IS NAMED.

GEORGE BOOLE

16. AS A CONSERVATIVE SENATOR FROM OHIO, HE WAS KNOWN AS "MR. REPUBLICAN." HE CO-SPONSORED A MEASURE THAT BEARS HIS NAME TODAY, A 1947 LAW THAT OUTLAWS CLOSED SHOPS. IDENTIFY THIS POLITICIAN WHO UNSUCCESSFULLY SOUGHT THE REPUBLICAN PRESIDENT NOMINATION THREE TIMES AND WAS THE SON OF A FORMER PRESIDENT AND CHIEF JUSTICE.

ROBERT TAFT (PROMPT ON: TAFT)

17. THERE ARE TWO FORMS OF THIS SPORT, ONE IN TRACK AND FIELD, AND THE OTHER AN EQUESTRIAN EVENT. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS ACTIVITY THAT CONTAINS A COURSE OF SUPER-SIZED HURDLES, AND PITS OF WATER THAT SERVE AS OBSTACLES.

STEEPLECHASE

18. ITS FLAG CONSISTS OF TWO HORIZONTAL BANDS OF BLUE AND YELLOW, AND IT IS THE LARGEST NATION (IN AREA) ENTIRELY LOCATED IN EUROPE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS NATION, THE FORMER BREADBASKET OF THE SOVIET UNION AND HOME TO FIGURE SKATING GOLD MEDALISTS VIKTOR PETRENKO AND OKSANA BAIUL.

UKRAINE

19. ALSO KNOWN AS CACTUS BUTTONS, OR PEYOTE, THIS DRUG INDUCES HALLUCINATIONS AND AFFECTS SENSATIONS AND PERCEPTIONS, WHILE IT CAN ALSO CAUSE A LOSS OF CONTROL OF THOUGHT PROCESSES. FOR TEN POINT, NAME THIS DRUG USED IN CEREMONIES BY SOME NATIVE AMERICANS.

20. ANNA KATHARINA EMMERICH WAS ONE, AS WAS SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI, NOT TO MENTION THE "LOVE AND ROCKETS" COMIC BOOK CHARACTER ERRATA. FOR TEN POINTS, ALL THESE PEOPLE, WHO PERIODICALLY DEVELOPED SPONTANEOUS WOUNDS ON THEIR BODIES THAT MIRRORED THE WOUNDS RECEIVED BY JESUS AT HIS CRUCIFIXION, ARE KNOWN BY WHAT NAME?
