JOSEPH PRIESTLEY

2. IT IS THE RATE OF INTEREST THAT COMMERCIAL BANKS CHARGE ON SHORT TERM LOANS TO MAJOR CORPORATIONS. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS RATE THAT IS VERY INFLUENTIAL IN DETERMINING THE OTHER INTEREST RATES CHARGED BY BANKS.

AARON COPLAND

4. THIS ENGLISH POET AND DRAMATIST DEVELOPED THE USE OF DRAMATIC FREE VERSE. IN 1593, HE WAS STABBED TO DEATH IN A TAVERN BRAWL. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS PLAYWRIGHT WHO PENNED DR. FAUSTUS, TAMBURLAINE, AND EDWARD II.

CHRISTOPHER MARLOWE

5. THE OLDEST GREEK LETTER SOCIETY IN THE U.S. WAS FOUNDED IN 1776 AT WILLIAM AND MARY COLLEGE IN VIRGINIA. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS SOCIETY WHICH IS CONSIDERED THE MOST PRESTIGIOUS U.S. HONOR SOCIETY FOR LIBERAL ARTS STUDENTS.

PHI BETA KAPPA

6. THE CENTRAL DOCTRINE OF THIS RELIGIOUS MOVEMENT IS THAT THE SECOND COMING IS ALMOST HERE. THE MOVEMENT WAS FOUNDED IN 1872 BY CHARLES TAZE RUSSELL, IN PITTSBURGH. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS RELIGION WHOSE MEMBERS ARE FAMOUS FOR DISTRIBUTING PAMPHLETS DOOR-TO-DOOR.

JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES

7. "PRINCESS IN LOVE," THE STORY OF THE ALLEGED AFFAIR BETWEEN PRINCESS DIANA AND MAJOR JAMES HEWITT IS WRITTEN BY THE GRANDNIECE OF THE 1958 WINNER OF THE NOBEL PRIZE FOR LITERATURE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS RUSSIAN AUTHOR WHO IS BEST KNOWN FOR HIS ONLY NOVEL, "DOCTOR ZHIVAGO."

BORIS PASTERNAK

8. IN ASTRONOMY, THIS SIX-LETTER WORD IS USED TO DEFINE THE POINT ON THE CELESTIAL SPHERE DIRECTLY ABOVE AN OBSERVER AND EXACTLY 90 DEGREES FROM THE CELESTIAL HORIZON. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS WORD, THE OPPOSITE OF NADIR, WHICH IS ALSO KNOWN AS A BRAND OF APPLIANCES.

JOHN JAY

11. JAMES FENIMORE COOPER IS BEST KNOWN FOR A SERIES OF NOVELS FEATURING THE SCOUT NATTY BUMPO. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS SERIES, WHICH INCLUDES THE PRAIRIE, THE PATHFINDER, THE DEERSLAYER, AND THE LAST OF THE MOHICANS.
