TOM JONES

6. A liberal French social philosopher/historian of the 19th century, this man served briefly as French foreign minister after the Revolution of 1848. He is most well know however for his work, "Democracy in America", which was the first impartial study of institutions in the US. FOR TEN POINTS, name him.

Alexis de Tocqueville

7. HE MAINTAINED THAT THE MEANS OF COMMUNICATIONS HAS A GREATER INFLUENCE ON PEOPLE THAN THE INFORMATION IT CARRIES. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS WRITER AND COMMUNICATIONS THEORIST WHO COINED THE PHRASES "GLOBAL VILLAGE" AND "THE MEDIA IS THE MESSAGE."

HERBERT MARSHALL MCLUHAN

8. SIR HUMPHREY GILBERT CLAIMED THIS ISLAND FOR ENGLAND IN 1583. BUT ALMOST 600 YEARS EARLIER, THE VIKINGS HAD SETTLED THERE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS CANADIAN ISLAND PROVINCE WHOSE GRAND BANKS ARE THE PREMIER COD FISHING GROUNDS IN THE WORLD AND WHOSE CAPITAL IS ST. JOHN'S.

11. A TROUBLED HOUSEWIFE, A SEXUALLY CHARGED IRRESPONSIBLE WOMAN WHO DOESN'T RECOGNIZE HER OWN CHILD AND A HEALTHY EDUCATED SOPHISTICATE COMBINATION THAT FINALLY EMERGES FROM THE FIRST TWO. FOR TEN POINTS, IN WHAT 1958 FILM ARE ALL OF THESE CHARACTERS PLAYED BY JOANNE WOODWARD?

16. A NEW BIOGRAPHY NOTES THAT BY THE TIME OF HIS DEATH IN 1973 THIS MAN WAS EITHER FORGOTTEN OR DESPISED, A LONG COME DOWN FOR SOMEONE WHO HELD THE NATION'S ATTENTION WITH HIS GOSSIPY NEWS COLUMNS AND RAPID FIRE RADIO REPORTS IN THE 1930'S AND 40'S. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THE MAN REMEMBERED FOR HIS OPENING "GOOD EVENING MR. AND MRS AMERICA AND ALL THE SHIPS AT SEA."

WALTER WINCHELL

17. THIS ONE TIME PSYCHOLOGY PROFESSOR AT HARVARD WAS ONE OF THE FIRST THEORISTS TO SUGGEST THAT HUMANS, LIKE OTHER ANIMALS, POSSESS INSTINCTS. HE ALSO OPPOSED THE PARADIGM THAT HUMAN IDENTITY IS GROUNDED IN METAPHYSICS, ARGUING IT WAS GROUNDED IN BEHAVIOR. FOR TEN POINTS NAME THIS BROTHER OF A PROMINENT AMERICAN NOVELIST.

WILLIAM JAMES

18. JACOB AMMAN WAS THE FOUNDER OF THIS 16TH CENTURY RELIGIOUS SECT, WHICH AROSE AS A SUBSET OF THE SWISS ANABAPTIST MOVEMENT. THEIR BELIEFS ARE EMBODIED IN THE *DORDRECHT CONFESSION OF FAITH*. THEIR PRIMARY U.S. BRANCH IS THE AMISH CHURCH OF SOUTHEAST PENNSYLVANIA FOR TEN POINTS, IDENTIFY THIS GROUP WHO DERIVED THEIR NAME FROM DUTCH REFORMER MENNO SIMONS.

MENNONITES

19. SHE GRADUATED SUMMA CUM LAUDE FROM SMITH COLLEGE, THE DAUGHTER OF AN AUTOCRATIC PRUSSIAN BIOLOGIST. SHE WENT ON TO CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY WHERE SHE MET AND MARRIED THE ENGLISH POET TED HUGHES. FOR TEN POINTS NAME THIS AMERICAN POET WHOSE LIFE IS CHRONICLED IN "THE BELL JAR."

SYLVIA PLATH

20. "We will have to repent in this generation not merely for the hateful words and actions of the bad people but for the appalling silence of the good people." FOR TEN POINTS, what clergyman and 1964 Nobel Peace Laureate wrote these words in his essay, "Letter from a Birmingham Jail" in 1963?

21. IT IS THE HOME OF THE WORLD'S LARGEST FRESHWATER AQUARIUM AND LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS LARGE TENNESSEE CITY.

RIO DE JANEIRO

24. YOU MAY NOT HAVE HEARD OF WILL WRIGHT, BUT MILLIONS OF COMPUTER SCREENS HAVE. IN 1989 HIS VIDEO GAME DEBUTED AS A BEST-SELLER. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS GAME THAT ALLOWS THE PLAYER TO EXPERIENCE THE TRIALS AND TRIBULATIONS OF RUNNING A COMPLEX URBAN SYSTEM.

SIMCITY

25. IN 1961, HE OVERSAW THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BERLIN WALL UNDER THE TUTELAGE OF THEN PARTY LEADER WALTER ULBRICHT WHOM HE REPLACED IN 1971. FOR TEN POINTS NAME THIS FORMER EAST GERMAN LEADER, AN UNREPENTANT TOTALITARIAN, WHO DIED IN SANTIAGO, CHILE IN MAY 1994.

26. According to Tori Amos, he does his crossword puzzles in pen. FOR TEN POINTS, name this Eastern philosopher of ancient China whose *Analects* contain a collections of his famous sayings compiled by his disciples after his death.

27. ONE UNNAMED OFFICIAL COMPLAINED THAT "SOME TYRANT WILL SAY I DON'T HAVE TO LISTEN TO THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE, BECAUSE I CAN ALWAYS GO TO ATLANTA AND GET A BETTER DEAL." 3) This order grew out of an 11th Century pilgrims hospital in the Holy Land. They moved on to Rhodes, defending it until 1522. Given Malta by Charles V, they defeated the Turks there at Lepanto in 1571.

Knights Hospitalers, or Knights of St. John of Jerusalem, (or of Rhodes, or of Malta)

In 1893, while director of the National Conservatory in New York City, he wrote his best known work, which conveyed his impressions of American scenes while evoking nostalgia for his native land.
