THE AUTHOR OF SUCH WORKS AS "IN SEARCH OF LOVE AND BEAUTY", "HEAT AND DUST", AND "THREE CONTINENTS", SHE IS MORE FAMOUS FOR HER SCREENPLAYS FOR THE JAMES IVORY AND ISMAIL MERCHANT PRODUCTIONS: "A ROOM WITH A VIEW", "HOWARD'S END", AND "THE REMAINS OF THE DAY". FOR TEN POINTS, NAME HER.

4. SOME CIVIL WAR GENERALS WERE MORE FAMOUS OR INFAMOUS AFTER THE WAR THAN DURING THE WAR. FOR 10 POINTS NAME THIS CONFEDERATE GENERAL WHO WAS LATER TO FOUND THE KU KLUX KLAN

NATHAN BEDFORD FORREST

5. LIKE HENRY VIII, HE ALSO HAD SIX WIVES. IN 774, HE WAS CROWNED KING OF THE LOMBARDS. IN 778, HE TOOK NORTHEAST SPAIN FROM THE MOORS AND IN 788, HE ANNEXED BAVARIA. IN 800, HE RESTORED LEO III TO THE PAPACY AND WAS CROWNED HOLY ROMAN EMPEROR BY HIM. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS CAROLINGIAN KING WHOSE LEGEND HAS LIVED UP TO HIS NAME OF CHARLES THE GREAT.

CHARLEMAGNE

6. FANS WILL MISS HIS WORK WHEN HE RETIRES AT THE END OF THIS YEAR. THIS MAN MADE GIANT INSECTS, TALKING ANIMALS, AND GEEKY LOOKING CHARACTERS VERY POPULAR IN HIS SOMETIMES BIZARRE, BUT ALMOST ALWAYS FUNNY COMIC STRIP, THE FAR SIDE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME HIM.

GARY LARSON

7. LOCATED IN UTAH, COLORADO, ARIZONA AND NEW MEXICO, THEY WERE BUILT ON MESAS OF STONE AND ADOBE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THESE ANCIENT APARTMENTS, OR THE NATIVE AMERICANS WHO BUILT THEM.

PUEBLOS

8. THE NAME THEY TOOK SOUNDS MORE APPROPRIATE FOR A SWING ERA WOMEN'S SINGING ENSEMBLE, BUT THIS FIERCELY MILITANT LABOR GROUP STRUCK TERROR IN THE HEARTS OF COAL MINE OWNERS IN PENNSYLVANIA IN THE LATE 19TH CENTURY. FOR 10 POINTS NAME THE GROUP.

THE MOLLY MAGUIRES

9. ORIGINALLY NAMED VAN DIEMEN'S LAND, THIS FORMER PENAL COLONY IS NOW AN AUSTRALIAN STATE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS ISLAND LOCATED ON THE SE COAST OF THE AUSTRALIAN MAINLAND AND WHICH SHARES ITS NAME WITH A "DEVILISH" LOONEY TUNES CHARACTER.

TASMANIA

10. THIS BAND IS NAMED AFTER THE SPOILED LITTLE RICH GIRL WHO TURNS INTO A GIANT BLUEBERRY IN "CHARLIE AND THE CHOCOLATE FACTORY". THEIR DEBUT CD IS "AMERICAN THIGHS". FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS ALL-FEMALE BAND WITH THE HIT "SEETHER."

VERUCA SALT

11. IT WAS BUILT IN 1889 FOR ITS CITY'S EXPOSITION. IT IS TOPPED BY A WEATHER STATION SITTING ALMOST 430 FEET HIGHER THAN THE WASHINGTON MONUMENT. FOR TEN POINTS WHAT IS THIS 7,300 TON IRON AND STEEL EUROPEAN LANDMARK?

EIFFEL TOWER

12. KARL SCHAEFER, BEATRIX SCHUBA, JOHN CURRY, TENLEY ALBRIGHT, RICHARD BUTTON, CAROL HEISS, ROBIN COUSINS, SONJA HENIE, BRIAN BOITANO, AND KATARINA WITT. THEY ALL ARE OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALISTS IN, FOR TEN POINTS, WHAT SPORT?

FIGURE SKATING OR ICE SKATING

13. THIS PIECE WAS FIRST WRITTEN AS ONE OF A NUMBER OF PATRIOTIC PIECES FOR THE CINCINNATI SYMPHONY. THE COMPOSER LATER USED IT TO INTRODUCE THE FINAL MOVEMENT OF HIS THIRD SYMPHONY. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS FAMOUS COPLAND FANFARE.

FANFARE FOR THE COMMON MAN

14. MEMBERS OF THIS REFORMED FAITH ARE OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE "FROZEN CHOSEN." FOUNDED IN SCOTLAND BY JOHN KNOX AND STRONGLY INFLUENCED BY CALVINISM, THIS DENOMINATION SPREAD TO THE US IN 1706. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS PROTESTANT DENOMINATION.

PRESBYTERIANISM OR PRESBYTERIAN

15. THE GREAT CLASSICAL EPIC POEMS OFTEN SERVED TO PROVIDE MYTHICAL EXPLANATIONS FOR HISTORICAL REALITIES. ACCORDING TO THIS LATIN EPIC POEM, THE ROOTS OF THE HATRED BETWEEN ROME AND CARTHAGE WHICH CULMINATED IN THE PUNIC WARS LAY IN A LOVE AFFAIR GONE BAD. FOR 10 POINTS, NAME THIS EPIC POEM WRITTEN BY VIRGIL AT THE BEHEST OF CEASAR AUGUSTUS.

THE AENEID

16. BASEBALL IS GONE, BUT HOPEFULLY NOT FORGOTTEN. IN 1993 THE MORE PRESTIGIOUS AWARDS IN THE NATIONAL LEAGUE WENT TO REPEAT WINNERS. BARRY BONDS WON THE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER AWARD FOR THE SECOND TIME AND FOR TEN POINTS WHO WAS THE REPEAT WINNER OF THE CY YOUNG AWARD?

GREG MADDUX

17. THIS SCHOOL OF PSYCHOLOGY INTERPRETS PHENOMENA AS ORGANIZED WHOLES, RATHER THAN AS AGGREGATES OF DISTINCT PARTS. IT WAS BROUGHT TO THE US IN THE 1930'S BY GERMAN REFUGEE PSYCHOLOGISTS. 18. IN 1993, HE BECAME THE FIRST NATURALIZED CITIZEN TO BE APPOINTED TO THIS NATIONAL POSITION. BORN IN POLAND, HE IMMIGRATED TO THE U. S. IN 1944. FOR 10 POINTS, WHO IS THIS CURRENT CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF?

JOHN SHALIKASHVILI

19. LADY CAROLINE LAMB WROTE "MAD, BAD, AND DANGEROUS TO KNOW" ABOUT HIM IN HER JOURNAL AFTER FIRST MEETING HIM AT A BALL. DESPITE HER FIRST IMPRESSION, SHE FELL FOR HIM AND THEY HAD A TORRID AFFAIR. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS POET WHO WROTE "THE PRISONER OF CHILLON", "CHILDE HAROLDE'S PILGRIMAGE", AND "DON JUAN".

GEORGE GORDON, OR LORD BYRON

20. THIS CIVILIZATION'S LANGUAGE CANNOT BE CLASSIFIED INTO ANY KNOWN GROUP OF LANGUAGES. IT WAS COMPRISED OF A CONFEDERATION OF CITY STATES, INCLUDING CLUSIUM, TARQUINII, VEII, VOLTERRA, AND PERUSIA. THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF METALWORKING AND FINE POTTERY LED THEM TO THEIR PEAK DURING THE 6TH CENTURY BC, MAKING THEM THE HIGHEST CIVILIZATION IN ITALY BEFORE THE RISE OF THE ROMANS. FOR TEN POINTS. 21. THE EFFECTS OF TV VIOLENCE HAVE BEEN QUESTIONED CONCERNING THIS 5 YEAR OLD GIRL'S DEATH IN NORWAY. STONED AND KICKED, THEN LEFT TO FREEZE IN THE SNOW BY 3 MALE PLAYMATES HER AGE, HER DEATH HAS STUNNED HER NATION. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME HER.

SILJE MARIE REDERGARD

22. BILL WATTERSON'S COMIC STRIP CALVIN AND HOBBS IS IMMENSELY POPULAR. THE FACT IS PROVEN YET AGAIN AS THIS BOOK, THE MOST RECENT COLLECTION, IS #1 ON THE PUBLISHERS WEEKLY BESTSELLER LIST FOR TRADE PAPERBACKS. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME IT, THE TITLE OSTENSIBLY DESCRIBING HOBBS.

PSYCHO JUNGLE CAT

23. THE WORD FOR ZERO IN THIS SPORT COMES FROM THE FRENCH FOR EGG. THE MODERN VERSION WAS DEVELOPED IN 1873 BY MAJOR WALTER WINGFIELD. THE FIRST WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP WAS HELD IN 1872 IN WIMBLEDON, ENGLAND, AND HAS REMAINED A FAMOUS AND IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT EVER SINCE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS SPORT WHOSE STARS INCLUD STEFFI GRAF AND PETE SAMPRAS.

TENNIS

24. THE NAME'S THE SAME. PEGGY WAS A NOTED ART PATRON, COLLECTOR, AND DEALER WHO IN 1941 MARRIED AND DIVORCED MAX ERNST. SOLOMON WAS AN INDUSTRIALIST, COLLECTOR AND PHILANTHROPIST AND FOUNDED A FOUNDATION NAMED AFTER HIM. IN 1943, HE COMMISSIONED FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT TO DESIGN A MUSEUM IN NEW YORK CITY TO HOUSE HIS COLLECTION. FOR TEN POINTS, GIVE THE NAME.

GUGGENHEIM

25. THIS IS A SYSTEM OF THOUGHT OPPOSED TO METAPHYSICS AND MAINTAINS THAT THE GOAL OF KNOWLEDGE IS TO DESCRIBE THE PHENOMENA EXPERIENCED. THE TERM WAS COINED BY AUGUSTE COMTE AND EXPONENTS INCLUDED FRANCIS BACON, GEORGE BERKELEY, AND DAVID HUME. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME IT.

POSITIVISM

26. ALL PLANT AND ANIMAL CELLS CONTAIN MITOCHONDRIA, CELL MEMBRANES, RIBOSOMES, AND ENDOPLASMIC RETICULUM. BUT, FOR TEN POINTS, NAME EITHER OF THE TWO STRUCTURES THAT PLANT CELLS HAVE AND ANIMAL CELLS DO NOT.

CELL WALLS OR CHLOROPLASTS

ANNE

29. HE DID HIS MAJOR WORK IN THE PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE. HE ALSO DID WORK IN BALLISTICS, BUT IS BEST REMEMBERED FOR THE RATIO BETWEEN THE SPEED OF AN OBJECT AND THE SPEED OF SOUND IN THE MEDIUM IN WHICH THE OBJECT IS TRAVELING. FOR TEN POINTS. NAME THIS MAN WHOSE NUMBER IS USUALLY USED TO DETERMINE A PLANE'S SPEED.

ERNST MACH
