HE SERVED WITH A FRENCH AMBULANCE UNIT AND THE ITALIAN RED CROSS BEFORE BECOMING A JOURNALIST. HE WROTE TWO WAR-INSPIRED NOVELS BUT FOR TEN POINTS NAME THIS AUTHOR WHO IS BEST REMEMBERED FOR "MANHATTAN TRANSFER" AND THE USA TRILOGY.

8. IT RESEMBLES A DUTCH TOWN WITH ITS MANY CANALS AND DRAWBRIDGES AND WAS FOUNDED IN 1619 AS THE FORT OF BATAVIA FOR THE DUTCH EAST INDIA COMPANY. IT WAS RENAMED IN 1949 AND IS THE HOME OF ONE OF THE WORLD'S BEST COLLECTIONS OF ASIAN PORCELAIN IN ITS NATIONAL MUSEUM. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS SOUTHEAST ASIAN CAPITAL.

10. HE HAS A LAW DEGREE AND SPENT A POSTGRADUATE SUMMER STUDYING IN OXFORD, ENGLAND. HIS NEW JOB IS GOING WONDERFULLY; HE HASN'T LOST A GAME YET. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS AUBURN UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL COACH WHO SET A SCHOOL RECORD OF 18 STRAIGHT WINS.

TERRY BOWDEN

11. WHILE HE DIDN'T INVENT THE LIMERICK, HE IS CREDITED WITH ESTABLISHING ITS POPULARITY. ALL OF HIS OWN POEMS WERE CHARACTERISTICALLY CHARACTERIZED BY HIM AS "NONSENSE PURE AND ABSOLUTE." FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS AUTHOR OF "THE BOOK OF NONSENSE" AND "THE OWL AND THE PUSSYCAT."

EDWARD LEAR

12. THIS INSTITUTION'S PRESENT FORM DATES BACK TO THE 12TH CENTURY. IN 1586, ITS NUMBER OF MEMBERS WAS LIMITED TO 70 BUT IN 1959 THIS NUMBER WAS INCREASED ALTHOUGH THE NUMBER WHO COULD PARTICIPATE IN ELECTIONS WAS LIMITED TO 120. IN 1962 IT WAS ESTABLISHED THAT ALL OF ITS MEMBERS MUST BE BISHOPS BY POPE JOHN XXIII. FOR TEN POINTS IDENTIFY THIS GROUP WHO ARE THE CHIEF ADVISERS OF THE POPE AND HEAD OF PAPAL ELECTIONS.

COLLEGE OF CARDINALS

13. His chief contribution to the Supreme Court was his administrative efficiency. His contribution to the Presidency was a continuation of his predecessor's trust-busting. FOR TEN POINTS, name this man, appointed chief justice in 1921 by President Harding.

William Howard Taft

14. He co-founded the Dadaist movement in art, inventing complex nonfunctional machines and commonplace objects that he exhibited as art and . He is also noted for his cubist-futurist works, including *Nude Descending a Staircase*. FOR TEN POINTS, name this French artist.

16. THIS DUTCH PHYSIOLOGIST INVENTED A STRING GALVANOMETER THAT COULD BE USED TO RECORD THE ACTION OF THE HEART. FOR FIFTEEN POINTS IDENTIFY THIS MAN, WINNER OF THE 1924 NOBEL PRIZE AND INVENTOR OF THE EKG.

WILLIAM EINTHOVEN

17. JENNIFER TILLY, CHAZZ PALMINTERI, MARY LOUISE PARKER, ROB REINER, TRACEY ULLMAN, DIANNE WUEST AND JOHN CUSACK. THESE ACTORS ALL STAR, FOR TEN POINTS, IN WHAT CRITICALLY ACCLAIMED NEW FILM OF BROADWAY FARCE, SET IN THE ROARING TWENTIES THAT MARKS THE RETURN OF WOODY ALLEN TO THE BIG SCREEN?

BULLETS OVER BROADWAY

18. Her work as a nurse in the early 20th Century convinced her that family limitation through birth control was necessary for social progress. In spite of arrests and indictments, she led both American and International birth control movements and helped establish clinics all over the world. FOR TEN POINTS, name her.

19. NATURE IS USUALLY A MAIN THEME IN THE WORKS OF THIS 19TH CENTURY RUSSIAN. HIS WORK "A HUNTER'S SKETCHES" RESULTED IN HIS ARREST AND EXILE. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS AUTHOR WHOSE PORTRAYAL OF PEASANT LIFE MADE HIM A RUSSIAN HERO.

IVAN TURGENEV

20. THEY BELIEVED IN THE PRIMACY OF THE BIBLE, SEPARATION OF CHURCH FROM STATE AND OF BELIEVERS AND NONBELIEVERS. THEY ALSO HELD THAT INFANT BAPTISM IS NOT AUTHORIZED IN SCRIPTURE AND SHOULD ONLY BE ADMINISTERED TO BELIEVERS. FOR TEN POINTS, NAME THIS RADICAL SECT OF THE 16TH CENTURY REFORMATION LED BY THOMAS MUNZER AND JOHN OF LEIDEN.

24. THE STATUE OF LIBERTY IN 1986, THE CONSTITUTION IN 1987, GEORGE WASHINGTON IN 1982, THOMAS JEFFERSON IN 1994, THE KOREAN WAR IN 1991, AND THE OLYMPICS IN 1984 AND 1992. ALL THESE EVENTS OR PEOPLE ARE FEATURED ON COMMEMORATIVE VERSIONS OF, FOR TEN POINTS, WHAT MONETARY ITEM USED IN THE U.S. IN DENOMINATIONS OF DOLLAR, HALF DOLLAR, QUARTER, DIME, NICKEL, AND CENT?

COIN (DO NOT ACCEPT ANY SPECIFIC DENOMINATION)
