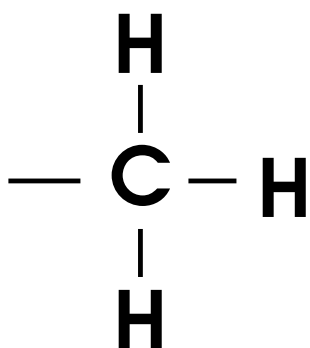


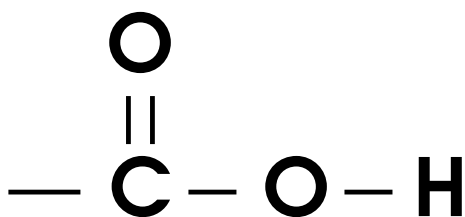
BONUS 2: Name the functional groups.
