\ALLELE\

4. Known as the first national hero of France, he managed to unite almost all the tribes of Gaul against Caesar and beat back his legions, until making the mistake of retiring to the walled city of Alesia, where Caesar laid siege and captured him. FTP, name this Gallic leader whose surrender ended organized resistance to Roman rule in Gaul.

\VERCINGETORIX\

5. Celebrating four hundred years of blissful marriage in 1995 are Lysander and Hermia, Demetrius and Helena, and Theseus and Hippolyta, as well as four hundred years after reconciliation for the king and queen of the fairies, Oberon and Titania. FTP, these characters are found in what Shakespeare play, first performed in 1595?

\A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM\

6. Born in Kent and apprenticed to a cloth dealer in 1438, he established his own business in Bruges and became governor of the English merchants there, in Flanders. However, his fame lies not in his financial or political success, but in a trade he learned at the age of fifty. FTP, name the man who popularized Thomas Malory's Morte D'Arthur and was England's first printer.

7. Its name comes from a native word meaning "place of meeting". This provincial capital contains a million residents within city limits, 53,000 of which can fit in the Skydome. FTP, name this city, whose metropolitan population of almost 4 million makes it the largest in Canada.

\TORONTO\

8. The American League Most Valuable Player twice, he led the Detroit Tigers to two world championships. FTP, name this slugger who won the home run title four times, hammering 58 in 1938, the most by any right-handed hitter in the history of baseball.
