

1996 Michigan MLK Memorial Question License

This license applies to all users of these questions, whether the questions were obtained from Michigan Buzzer Competitions (MBC) or another source. By retaining possession of these questions, you agree to abide by the conditions below. If you have possession of these questions and cannot or will not abide by the terms of this agreement, return the question immediately to:

We will take all necessary action against violators of this license to enforce our rights.

Acceptable Uses of the Questions:

1. They may be traded only to other collegiate programs in non-monetary trades. The only fees which may be charged are the exact cost of photocopying (or of a disk, as appropriate) and mailing. If they are traded, a copy of this notice must be distributed with the questions.
2. They may be used only for:
 - a. collegiate practices, and
 - b. scrimmages with other collegiate programs, so long as (a) there is no charge beyond subsistence fees (the exact cost necessary to cover photocopying, rooms, etc.) and (b) the source of the questions is made public. In this case, MBC would like a courtesy notification of the event, and a courtesy list of all discovered errors in the questions, as well as protests that arose during play (we want a complete list of all known problems).
3. They may be stored indefinitely in archives for permissible future uses.
4. They may be used in charity fundraising events involving collegiate programs, so long as MBC is notified, and the source of the questions is publicly identified.
5. They may not be quoted publicly or used in derivative form, except:
 - a. It is acceptable to analyze the content of the questions to discover the frequency of certain topics, patterns of writing, or other like results. Within one year of the questions' initial use, the results of any analysis may be distributed, even at a cost, so long as they do not diminish the market value or security of the questions. Afterward, they may be distributed regardless of these effects. Please provide MBC with a courtesy copy of any analysis involving the questions.
 - b. It is acceptable (under "fair use") to quote limited excerpts in a public forum for the purposes of debate, analysis, or scholarly criticism of the questions.

Other uses are prohibited without explicit prior permission from MBC.

This includes:

1. Posting of the questions in any form to any publicly accessible site.
2. Use of the questions in **any** for-profit event.
3. Selling the questions to anyone.
4. Distributing the questions to any non-collegiate person. "Distributing" includes making available in any form, selling, or exposing someone to the questions. "Non-collegiate" does not include persons reasonably affiliated with a collegiate program, such as coaches, former players, university staff, parents, non-high school friends of the players, and other similar persons, but does specifically include all high school and secondary school students.

Even though the questions will be posted to a public internet site after one year, the license still applies to the questions.
